{} DO NOT EAT OR DRINK ANYTHING AFTER MIDNIGHT THE NIGHT BEFORE SURGERY. If you take regularly scheduled medications you may take them with a sip of water unless instructed otherwise.	
{} DISCONTINUE ASPIRIN (or products containing aspirin) 7 days prior to your surgery. DISCONTINUE IBUPROFEN PRODUCTS 48 HOURS prior to surgery.	
{ } WEIGHT LOSS MEDICATIONS and any HERBAL MEDICATIONS should be discontinued 2 weeks prior to surgery.	
{} WE PREFER THAT anticoagulants be discontinued 5 days prior to your surgery. IF you are on any anticoagulants, you are responsible for contacting your prescribing physician to inform them of your surgery date and ask him/her TO NOTIFY US IF THE ANTICOAGULANT CAN BE DISCONTINUED 5 DAYS PRIOR TO YOUR SURGERY.	
{} IF YOU SMOKE, we suggest you stop at least 2 weeks prior to surgery.	
{ } A HIBICLENS SHOWER (an over the counter disinfectant solution) should be take the night before surgery as well as the morning of surgery to help reduce the chance of skin infection.	
{} SPECIAL PREPS are usually required prior to abdominal surgeries so please call us immediately if you leave our office without these instructions.	
{} IF YOU DEVELOP a fever, rash, cold symptoms or any other medic prior to your surgery please call to see if we need to cancel your surgery. (*(Phyllis at 472-1381 ext. 105)
